

CO-ED SLOW-PITCH RULES FOR TRI COUNTY

This division was created to let this age group have a level of ball to play and have fun.

All teams must have an adult (over 30) coach present at all games.

You are to alternate batting...girl , boy, girl.

Players may enter a game at any time.

A count of 4 and 0 to any batter allows the next batter (male or female) to walk. This is the batters choice.

There is a minimum arc of 6 feet with no maximum.

The pitcher must step on the rubber at some point in their delivery.

There is no touching the home plate. A line shall be provided.

If a team does not have 5 girls show up at the diamond they must play with what they have e.g. If only 2 girls show up, the two must play the entire game. The other team can play with the same amount or more. You can loan players to the other team if you so desire.

There is only 2 home run hitters (DH) allowed per game. The next home run is out and the play is dead and the runners do not advance. If the DH gets a 4-0 count the DH is open again.

There are unlimited foul balls.

Keep in mind all games are exhibition, there are no standings.

The bases are 65' with the pitching distance being 50'.

A 12" ball is used.

There is a maximum of 7 runs per team each inning.

There are 7 innings, with diamond scheduling applying.

No new inning to commence after 1.5hr from game start time.

There is no mercy rule, but a team may concede if they wish.

Helmets must be worn by all players, those 16 and under must wear helmets with face guard.

THERE IS TO BE NO DRINKING DURING OR PRIOR TO THE GAME. THIS INCLUDES FIELD, DUGOUT, STANDS AND PARKING LOT. ANYONE CAUGHT WILL BE EJECTED FROM THE GAME. THE GAME WILL BE STOPPED AND FORFEITED. 911 WILL BE CALLED IF SEEN. ONE WARNING AND AFTER THAT TEAM IS DONE FOR THE YEAR.
